







### **Places To Visit**




### **PASHUPATINATH**

Pashupatinath is one of the holiest temples in Nepal, dedicated to Lord Shiva. Located along the Bagmati River, this temple complex is an important religious site for Hindus. The temple is known for its pagoda-style architecture and the sacred cremation ghats on the riverbanks. It is a UNESCO World Heritage Site

### **BOUDHANATH STUPA**

Boudhanath Stupa is one of the largest Buddhist stupas in the world and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It is located in the eastern part of Kathmandu and is an important pilgrimage site for Tibetan Buddhists. The stupa has a large mandala and is surrounded by numerous monasteries and Tibetan shops.





### **KATHMANDU DURBAR SQUARE**

Kathmandu Durbar Square is a historical palace complex and one of the three Durbar Squares in the Kathmandu Valley, recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The square is home to several temples, courtyards, and the former royal palace, which has exquisite Newar architecture. The area is a mix of palaces, shrines, and historic monuments.

## **CHANDRAGIRI HILLS**

Chandragiri is a popular hill station and tourist destination located in the Kathmandu Valley, Nepal. It is 2,550 meters (8,366 feet) above sea level. The hill offers stunning panoramic views of the surrounding mountains, including the majestic peaks of the Himalayas, such as Mount Langtang, Ganesh Himal, and the Annapurna range. The Chandragiri Hill is most famous for its cable car ride, which takes visitors from the base to the top, offering scenic views of the valley and surrounding areas. At the summit, there is a view tower, and the area is often frequented by locals and tourists alike for its serene atmosphere, natural beauty, and as a spot for hiking.






### **Places To Visit**

#### **SWAYAMBHUNATH**

One of the most famous landmarks in Kathmandu, Swayambhunath is a stupa located atop a hill that offers panoramic views of the city. The site is also known as the "Monkey Temple" due to the large number of monkeys that inhabit the area. The stupa is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and is a significant pilgrimage site for both Buddhists and Hindus. The complex includes temples, shrines, and prayer wheels.





## **BHAKTAPUR DURBAR SQUARE**

Bhaktapur Durbar Square, located about 12 km from Kathmandu, is another UNESCO World Heritage Site known for its medieval architecture and artistry. It is famous for its beautiful palaces, temples, and the 55-Window Palace. Bhaktapur is also known for its traditional Newar culture, pottery, and delicious local food.

#### PATAN DURBAR SQUARE

Located in the city of Patan (Lalitpur), just across the Bagmati River from Kathmandu, Patan Durbar Square is another UNESCO World Heritage Site. Known for its stunning Newar architecture, it features temples, statues, and a museum housed in the old palace. Patan is also famous for its fine art and handicraft





### **NAGARKOT**

Nagarkot is a popular hill station located near Kathmandu, Nepal. Situated about 32 kilometers to the east of the capital, it is renowned for its stunning panoramic views of the Himalayan mountain range, including peaks like Mount Everest, Langtang, and Ganesh Himal. The region is also known for its natural beauty, lush forests, and serene environment, making it a favorite destination for hiking, bird watching, and photography. Nagarkot is particularly famous for its sunrise and sunset views, with tourists flocking to the area to witness the spectacular light play on the snow-capped peaks. The area offers a variety of accommodations, from basic guesthouses to luxury resorts, making it accessible for all types of travelers.
